

CIVIS student council

If you want to represent Stockholm University's students in an international context then CIVIS student council is the right forum for you!

CIVIS - A European Civic University - is a university alliance formed between eight European universities (Stockholm, Brussels, Madrid, Aix-Marseille, Tübingen, Rome, Athens, and Bucharest) with a common aim to collaborate on education and research and to facilitate student mobility and exchange opportunities.

The Student Council is completely new and consists of 4 student representatives (one PhD student, two students and one representative from SUS) from each university, 32 in total. The Student Council will be able to communicate directly with the Steering Committee of CIVIS, be involved in the writing process of the legal entity of CIVIS, propose content for upcoming CIVIS Days, among other things.

Number of meetings

The Student Council meets for 2 hour long meetings at least 3 times a year. However, the student representatives within CIVIS usually organize their own meetings roughly once a month in order to discuss important issues before the Steering Committee meetings. It is enough if one or two students from Stockholm participate in these meetings.

Language

The meetings are held in English.

Term of office

The term of office is 1 year, however, no commitments are binding.
