

# Central student Council, Centrala studentrådet (CSR)

The Central student Council (CSR) is SUS council for discussing all matters that concerns students at Stockholm University. CSR serves as an advisory body for SUS when it comes to these questions but can also act independently of SUS. CSR elects student representatives for several positions across university level.

- Knowledge about what is happening on faculty and central university level
- A broader circle of contacts within the university
- A merit for your résumé/CV
- Meeting compencation if you are a member of SUS

# Number of meetings per semester

4 meetings at approximately 2 hours.

### Language

The meetings are held in English and all the meeting papers are in English.

#### **Term**

Student representatives are elected from the faculty council's annual meeting until the next annual meeting. The annual meeting usually takes place in early December. If the student representative is elected at a meeting after the annual meeting, the term of office is then until the next annual meeting.

#### Meeting compencation

Members of the council receive SEK 250 per meeting. The chair, vice chair and secretary receive SEK 500 per meeting. To receive remuneration for your assignment, you must be a member of SUS.

#### What is expected of you as a representative:

# Prior knowledge

No prior knowledge is needed. The chair of the body is responsible for giving you an introduction. You can prepare questions and send an email to the chair of CSR if something is unclear.

# Before the meeting

About a week before the meeting, you will get a calling with the agenda and the documents. Read through these before the meeting to better understand the issues that will be discussed and the decisions that will be made.

# During the meeting

As an ordinary representative you have the right to speak and vote. As a suppliant you have the right to speak but you can only vote if you step in for one of the ordinary representatives. During the meeting you are expected to report to CSR from SFR.

### After the meeting

As a representative, you report back to SFR about things of relevance that were discussed or decided upon at the meetings you have participated in. You can also be present at the meetings and report directly to SFR.

#### Absence

If you for some reason cannot participate in a meeting, inform CSR at <u>csr@sus.se</u> and, as an ordinary representative, let your suppliant know.
