2. Reports from NFR representatives

ON:

- There is an upcoming meeting on Dec 1st.
- Bioinformatics and Molecular (BioPhysics) being closed as subjects.
- Master's program in geochemistry will be starting next year.
- New rules for dissertations will be approved
 - Main change is that both the defendant and the chair will need to be physically present, but all other people can be online.
 - Both genders should be represented on the dissertation committee.
 - Suggestion that this wording be changed to more than one gender should be represented. Nora will bring it forward.
 - Also an issue that job applications for SU only have two gender options
- There will be discussion about the research school for high school students in the summer mentors are needed for this.
- An equality report will be discussed.
- Katariina wishes to remind us that the NFR Presidium can always book a meeting with the dean (through Katariina) to discuss any issues.
- Point raised by Jonathan that halftime requirements have changed unclear how and if this is being implemented (especially requiring written report) across departments. Follow-up is needed.
 - For many students, a licentiate defence is listed in their ISP. Can this be changed, given the new rules?
 - Astronomy seems to be making licentiates mandatory to-date, and are still coupling 50% raise to licentiate defence (though change is in the process of being implemented). Mathematics feel the new halftime rules are just creating more work for those who did not plan to defend a licentiate.

GB: (Information also available in report)

- To become a teacher without doing an entire teaching programme, there used to be a program called KPU that took a year and a half and was complimentary to the main bachelor's education. The government shortened this program to one year.
- Ladok will be replaced by a new program (PLUPP) that makes things easier for teachers. The change will happen this spring.
- Ongoing project to hire science faculty communicator. Will this be a temporary position? Up for discussion. Do people know that communicator positions exist?
- GB approved two new master's programmes
- Why are SU physics and engineering students so scared of math, compared to KTH students? How does our reputation (as an academic, rather than applied university) affect who applies? Can we collaborate with KTH and share courses between programmes?
