7. <u>Discussion points</u>

7.1. PhD student group

- There has been some confusion regarding the PhD forum. It should be renamed to PhD dialogue instead. This will be brought up during the next dialogue on 8/2.
- Is there an overview of how many PhD students are in each department in the faculty?
- There will be a mentor program launched in February with 10 spots available. Is it the 10 spots for the entire university or the Faculty of Humanities. If it is 10 spots for the entire university, the students feel it is too competitive.
- Course evaluation for PhD programs should be standardised and anonymised.

7.2. Masters and Bachelor's student group

- Discussion on the status on the student councils are working, even if attendance is lower than before.
- In terms of the program names clashing with the actual outcome; this has not been experienced widely but could potentially clash.
- Online teaching, it Is not clear from the university when something can be
 online or not. Some course plans leave this open ended, so for students this is
 unclear and created unnecessary insecurity to students. It is also not specified
 to a standardized level which could be elaborated further to create guidelines
 on what the departments can and cannot do.
- Some clashing times clashing with holiday times creating some inequality among students as not everyone has family located in Stockholm.
